# **Praying to End Abortion at Planned Parenthood**



On May 1 Florida's Heartbeat Protection Act went into effect, protecting most innocent unborn human beings in their mother's wombs at the 6-week point. News crews showed up at Planned Parenthood, as did a strong contingent of pro-life prayer pals. Although the new law protects about 60% of preborn lives, abortion at Planned Parenthood sadly will continue for those preborn less than 6 weeks from conception. Our First Saturdays' Church Bus trip to Planned Parenthood following the 8:00am mass has been a success for the past 20 months. Come out and join us! The Bus departs around 8:45am from the Historic Church parking lot and returns to the same place around 10:30am. We supply Pro-life signs but bring your own Rosary. You don't have to climb aboard the bus, you can drive yourself and meet us at Planned Parenthood (5978 Powers Ave). The Holy Spirit has moved some of our parishioners to stand as witnesses, praying for the most vulnerable. Since our last Communiqué I witnessed 60 hours over a period of 34 days (several of those days I stood uncomfortably alone, so please get the word out to pro-life people to join me especially on weekdays). We observed 376 "customers" enter, received 3130 positive and 181 negative reactions from passersby, and passed out 31 "Blessing Bags" containing pro-life information. We also witnessed 2 potential and 2 firm SAVES during this time. Thank you Deacon DeLuca, Lucy, Normand, Savannah, Pat, Alan, Lana, Marilyn, Melissa, Alpha, Pauline, both Ricks, Barb, Bernadette, Fran, Mary Jane, Carol, Bill, Mattison, Kristin, Grace, Bryan, Brett, Nicole, Elaina, Tony, Maureen, Mike, Janine, David, Patty, Kathy, Kim, Joyce, Randy, Magdaly, Joseli, Adrianna, Vince, Gianna, George, Carileen, Robert, Luis, Carron, Russ, Max, Laura, Annette, John, Cindy, Adrea, and Caiden, and anyone else I may have missed who came out to stand up for the unborn at any of the 3 abortion clinics in Jacksonville. I invite, encourage, and pray that all St Joseph pro-lifers will do the same, as their circumstances permit. We continue to have difficulty maintaining a pro-life presence on the sidewalk at Planned Parenthood during weekday hours. Having young people on the sidewalk is a great visual and a resource to effectively communicate with "customers" who are members of the same generation.
