
UPDATE ON 2024 SAVE FROM PLANNED PARENTHOOD VIGIL


Women's Help Center Fund Raiser

Praying to End Abortion at Planned Parenthood





Our Lent **40 Days for Life** campaign ran from **March 5 - April 13**. We also had 2 special events coinciding with this campaign. The first was **Defunding Planned Parenthood Across America Life Chain** on March 29 spearheaded by Katie Yarborough and Savannah O'Brien. We had 67 prayer pals participate and had a display of 1,076 pink crosses representing the number of children Planned Parenthood kills in this country every day.



In our second event we joined the Family for LIFE group in the **Nationwide Rally to Defund Planned Parenthood** on April 2, the day that the Supreme Court of the United States heard arguments in the case of *Kerr v Planned Parenthood*, which will decide whether states can defund Planned Parenthood. This case was brought by Planned Parenthood against the state of

South Carolina and will likely determine if our state of Florida can prevent state Medicaid funds from going to Planned Parenthood. Our Respect Life Co-coordinator Savannah O'Brien led the group of 25 prayer pals advocating for the defunding of this evil organization.

"Pausing" First Saturdays' Church Bus Trips to Planned Parenthood. For the past 30 months we've transported prayer pals on our Church Bus every First Saturday to Planned Parenthood following the 8:00am Mass to pray for the unborn at risk. According to data from Florida AHCA, since the Heartbeat Protection Act went into effect in Florida on May 1, 2024, we experienced a 56% decline in the number of abortions in Jacksonville/Duval, comparing May-Dec 2023 (5,546) to May-Dec 2024 (2,427). Total numbers for the state of Florida for the entire year-to-year comparison of 2023 (84,052) to 2024 (64,854) show a 23% reduction in abortions. Positive news. Consequently, for the past several months none of the known abortion "doctors" have been seen at Planned Parenthood on Saturdays during our prayer vigils. Also, the Planned Parenthood website schedule appears to show that they are not performing abortions on Saturdays (hooray!) at least in the foreseeable future. Their customer traffic has been very low on that day as well. So, we're going to "pause" our regular monthly First Saturday Church Bus Trips to Planned Parenthood. Thank you to all those who participated in our trips.



Also, I'm altering my personal Saturday schedule for standing at Planned Parenthood. Until further notice I'm going to scale back and stand there on the 2nd and 4th Saturdays of the month. Prayer pals are encouraged to join me as their schedules permit.

First Saturday Prayers for the Unborn in St Joseph Cemetery. On the First Saturdays of the month, instead of the Church Bus Trip to Planned Parenthood, I am encouraging our prayer pals to join me in St Joseph Cemetery to pray for the Unborn. There is already a Christ Renews His Parish (CRHP) group that prays in our cemetery every First Saturday following the 8:00am Mass and we can join them. We have a vault in our Mausoleum with Unborn remains and we also have a Memorial to the Unborn. Both sites are appropriate places to pray for babies prematurely lost to stillbirth, miscarriage, and abortion...



If Planned Parenthood changes their schedule and starts to perform abortions again on Saturdays, we can restart the Church Bus trips (perhaps on a different Saturday of the month so members in the CRHP group have an opportunity to join us). Fr Ruchinski granted us the flexibility to restart Church Bus trips if necessary. And I will also go back to standing every Saturday if that happens. I continue to stand at Planned Parenthood on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays as usual. Please contact me if you are interested in joining me there on those days. Two good reasons for continuing to stand on some Saturdays are so we can interact with and educate the customers who continue to go to Planned Parenthood for other services, and we can monitor the facility to see if any abortion "doctors" begin to show up again on the weekend. Since our last Communiqué I witnessed 72 hours over 37 days with 70 prayer pals. We observed 384 "customers" enter, received 6,005 positive and 284 negative reactions from passersby, and passed out 28 "Blessing" Bags" containing pro-life information. We also witnessed 2 potential SAVES during this time. I invite, encourage, and pray that more St Joseph pro-lifers will do the same, as their circumstances permit. We have difficulty maintaining a pro-life presence on the sidewalk at Planned Parenthood during weekday hours. Young people on the sidewalk are a great visual and a resource to effectively communicate with "customers" who are members of the same generation. Please pass the word to faithful pro-life people you know. They do not have to be parishioners or Catholic. Recently we even have added a Muslim to our group of prayer pals. She stayed with our group while we prayed the Rosary and the Divine Mercy Chaplet (something most of our Protestant pals are unwilling to do). Death Penalty...Florida Executions




Edward James was executed March 20 by the state of Florida for the 1993 murders of Betty Dick and her granddaughter, Toni Neuner. Prompted by the FCCB's Advocacy Network, members of our Respect Life Community were encouraged to message/petition to Gov DeSantis to commute Edward's sentence to life without parole. That effort being unsuccessful, we held a special Holy Hour for Life on March 19 for Mr. James, his victims Betty Dick and Toni Neuner, and their families.

Michael Tanzi was executed April 8 by the state of Florida for the 2000 kidnapping and murder of Janet Acosta. Prompted by the FCCB's Advocacy Network, members of our Respect Life Community were encouraged to message/petition to Gov DeSantis to commute Michael's sentence to life without parole. That effort being unsuccessful, we held a special Holy Hour for Life on April 7 for Michael, his victim Janet Acosta, and her family.

Jeffrey Hutchinson was executed May 1 by the state of Florida for the 1998 murders of Renee Geoffrey, Amanda, and Logan Flaherty. Prompted by the FCCB's Advocacy Network, members of our Respect Life Community were encouraged to message/petition to Gov DeSantis to commute Edward's sentence to life without parole. That effort was unsuccessful. So, following the 8:00am morning Mass at the Historic Church Eucharistic Adoration was available in our Cody Center Chapel until 9:00pm for prayers. Intentions were made for Jeff and his victims immediately following exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at the beginning of the day. As Jeff's Spiritual Advisor Deacon Corky was with him on Wednesday and Thursday. Jeffrey received "Last Rites " from Bishop Emeritus Estevez on Wednesday and Deacon Corky was with Jeff inside the death chamber on Thursday.

Glen Rogers is scheduled to be executed on May 15. If you are a subscriber to the Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops, you should soon receive an email urging Gov Ron DeSantis to spare the life of Glen Rogers.
