Praying to End Abortion


First Saturday Prayers for the Unborn in St Joseph Cemetery. We held our first 3 events on the First Saturdays in June and July following the 8:00am Mass. This event was initiated due to our "pause" on the First Saturdays Church Bus Trips to Planned Parenthood. Our June event had 10 prayer pals meet in the St Joseph Cemetery to pray for the Unborn. In July we had a significant participation from the CRHP group as about 20 people joined us at the Monument to the Unborn and prayed the Divine Mercy Chaplet. Then 6 of our Respect Life folks then moved over to the Mausoleum's vaults to pray the Rosary, and the CRHP group prayed at the Crucifix in the center of the cemetery. On August 2 we prayed the Divine Mercy Chaplet at the Monument to the Unborn with about 15 prayer pals and joined several more CRHP folks at the Crucifix to pray the Rosary. The vaults in our Mausoleum (containing the St Vincent's vault for miscarried/stillborn babies and the vault for the Unborn) and Monument to the Unborn are appropriate places to pray for babies prematurely lost to stillbirth, miscarriage, and abortion at any time. Please join us on First Saturdays if you can.



We continue to have a reduced presence at Planned Parenthood on Saturdays to interact with and educate their customers who go for other services, and to see if any abortion "doctors" begin to show up again on the weekend. The last time an abortionist showed up at Planned Parenthood on a Saturday was on December 7. Since our last Communiqué I witnessed 67 hours over 37 days with 37 prayer pals. We observed 371 "customers" enter, received 5,071 positive and 217 negative reactions from passersby, and passed out 32 "Blessing Bags" containing pro-life information. We didn't witness any SAVES during this time. I invite, encourage, and pray that more St Joseph pro-lifers will come out as we have difficulty maintaining a pro-life presence on the sidewalk during weekday hours. Young people on the sidewalk are a great visual and a resource to effectively communicate with "customers" who are members of the same generation. Please pass the word to faithful pro-life people you know. They do not have to be parishioners or Catholic. Death Penalty...Florida Executions


Anthony Wainwright was executed June 10 by the state of Florida for the 1994 kidnapping, rape, and murder of Carmen Gayheart. Prompted by the FCCB's Advocacy Network, members of our Respect Life Community were encouraged to message/petition to Gov DeSantis to commute Anthony's sentence to life without parole. That effort was unsuccessful. So, following the 8:00am morning Mass at the Historic Church Eucharistic Adoration was available in our Cody Center Chapel until 9:00pm for prayers. Intentions were made for Anthony, his victim Carmen Gayheart, and her family and friends immediately following exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at the beginning of the day.

Thomas Gudinas was executed June 24 by the state of Florida for the 1994 rape and murder of Michelle McGrath. Prompted by the FCCB's Advocacy Network, members of our Respect Life Community were encouraged to message/petition to Gov DeSantis to commute Thomas' sentence to life without parole. That effort was unsuccessful. So, following the 8:00am morning Mass at the Historic Church Eucharistic Adoration was available in our Cody Center Chapel until 9:00pm for prayers. Intentions were made for Thomas, his victim Michelle, and her family and friends immediately following exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at the beginning of the day. We transported 7 members of our Respect Life Community in our Church Bus that evening to a prayer service, from 5:30-6:30pm, at the Florida State Prison, the site of the execution.

Michael Bell was executed July 15 by the state of Florida for the 1993 murders of Jimmy West and Tamecka Smith. Prompted by the FCCB's Advocacy Network, members of our Respect Life Community were encouraged to message/petition to Gov DeSantis to commute Michael's sentence to life without parole. That effort was unsuccessful. So, following the 8:00am morning Mass at the Historic Church Eucharistic Adoration was available in our Cody Center Chapel until 9:00pm for prayers. Intentions were made for Michael, his victims Jimmy West and Tamecka Smith, and their families and friends immediately following exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at the beginning of the day. We transported 9 members of our Respect Life Community in our Church Bus that evening to a prayer service, from 5:30-6:30pm, at the Florida State Prison, the site of the execution.

Edward Zakrzewski was executed by the state of Florida on July 31 for the 1994 murders of his wife Sylvia, son Edward, and daughter Anna. Prompted by the FCCB's Advocacy Network, members of our Respect Life Community were encouraged to message/petition to Gov DeSantis to commute Edward's sentence to life without parole. That effort was unsuccessful. So, following the 8:00am morning Mass at the Historic Church Eucharistic Adoration was available in our Cody Center Chapel until 9:00pm for prayers. Intentions were made for Ed, his victims Sylvia, Edward, and Anna Zakrzewski, and their families and friends immediately following exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at the beginning of the day. We transported 12 members of our Respect Life Community in our Church Bus that evening to a prayer service, from 5:30-6:30pm, at the Florida State Prison, the site of the execution.

Death Penalty Town Hall

On June 8 we hosted a presentation in the Cody Center..."Executing Hope: A Conversation with Florida Death Row Spiritual Advisors." Fr. Jeff Hood, an Old Catholic Priest from St. Oscar Romero Parish in Little Rock, AR, who is a Spiritual Advisor, Death Rows Nationwide, along with our Deacon Corky, conducted this Town-Hall style discussion on the Death Penalty from an inside the Death Chamber perspective, and through the eyes of the "Person" being executed. Fr. Jeff has accompanied 9 souls he has helped in their final moments through an execution. Deacon Corky recently escorted Sgt. Jeffrey G. Hutchinson, a former Army Ranger to his death by execution on May 1st. Bishop Felipe J. Estévez, S.T.D. (emeritus), John Chick (Coordinator, Diocese of St Augustine Prison Ministry Program), and Maureen Shilkunas (Director, Human Life & Dignity Office) were present along with about 40 community leaders, advocates for the abolishment of the death penalty, volunteers in Jail/Prison Ministry, and Respect Life Community members. The meeting was recorded as part of a documentary by Rolling Stone magazine about the Death Penalty.
