At this month's Muffins4Life event we received an eye-opening presentation by Ruby Peters, Human Trafficking Educator, Catholic Charities Bureau of the Diocese of St. Augustine and Northeast Florida Human Trafficking Coalition Ambassador. This is not solely an immigration issue; most victims and most human traffickers in our country are US Citizens. Vulnerable populations include minors in unstable situations, young people in general, drop-outs, runaways, the homeless, LGBTQ+, drug/alcohol abusers/addicts, foster children, special needs, and juvenile delinquents.



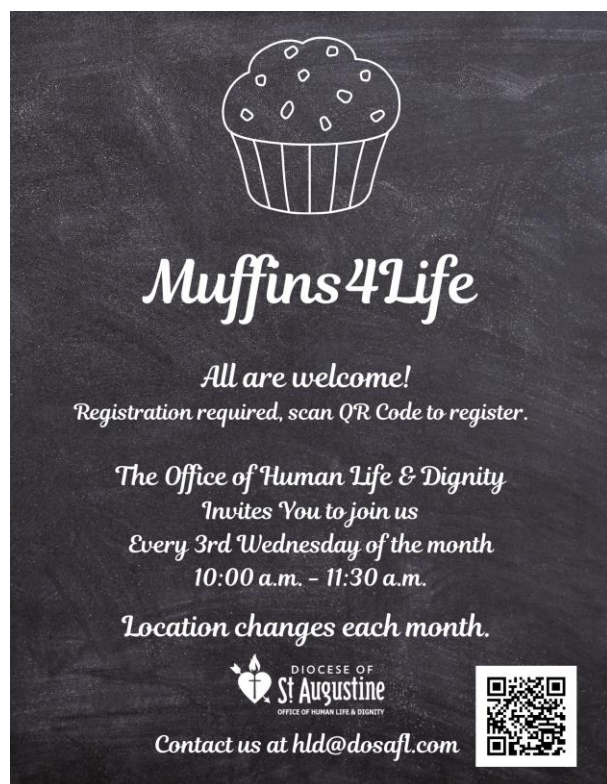
Praying to End Abortion

First Saturday Prayers for the Unborn in St Joseph Cemetery. We continue with these events on the First Saturdays following the 8:00am Mass. This event was initiated due to our “pause” on the First Saturdays Church Bus Trips to Planned Parenthood. We gather with the CRHP group at the Crucifix in the center of the cemetery and pray the Rosary and then move to the Monument to the Unborn and pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet. The vaults in our Mausoleum (containing the St Vincent's vault for miscarried/stillborn babies and the vault for the Unborn) are also appropriate places to pray for babies prematurely lost to stillbirth, miscarriage, and abortion at any time. Please join us on First Saturdays if you can.



It's been over a year since we last saw an abortionist show up at Planned Parenthood on a Saturday (on December 7, 2024). But we continue to have a reduced presence at Planned Parenthood on Saturdays to interact with and educate their customers who go for other services, and to see if any abortion "doctors" begin to show up again on the weekend. Since our last Communiqué I witnessed 46 hours over 21 days with 25 prayer pals. We observed 223 “customers” enter, received 3,270 positive and 107 negative reactions from passersby, and the Holy Spirit moved 16 women and a young man to accept a “Blessing Bag” containing pro-life information. We recorded a potential SAVE during this time as a volunteer at Women’s Help Center reported that a couple came to see them with one of the “Blessing Bags” we passed out. I invite, encourage, and pray that more St Joseph pro-lifers will come out as we have difficulty maintaining a pro-life presence on the sidewalk during weekday hours. Young people on the sidewalk are a great visual and a resource to effectively communicate with “customers” who are members of the same generation. Please pass the word to faithful pro-life people you know. They do not have to be parishioners or Catholic. 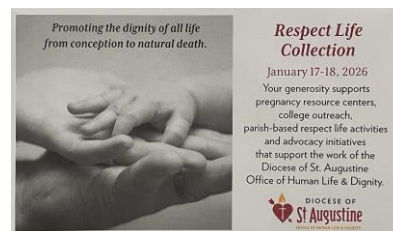


The next Muffins4Life event will be held on January 21 at L'Arche, a community for people with intellectual/developmental disabilities.

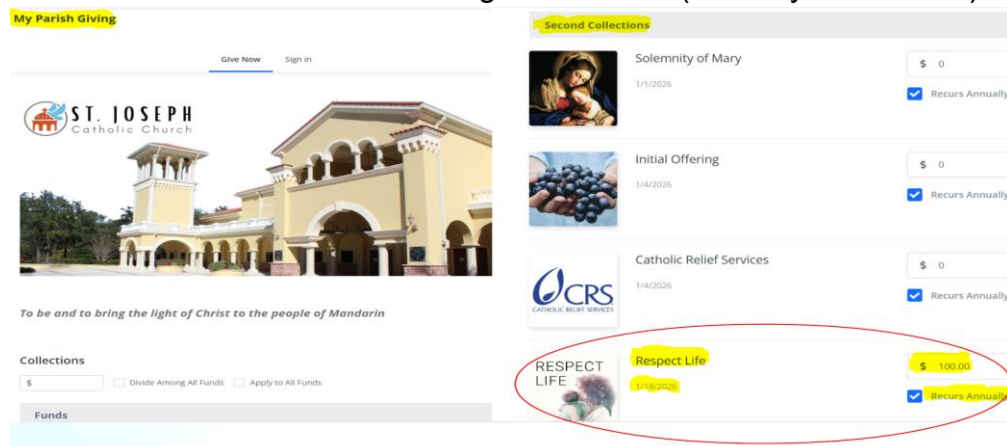


Respect Life Collection

Death Penalty...Florida Executions

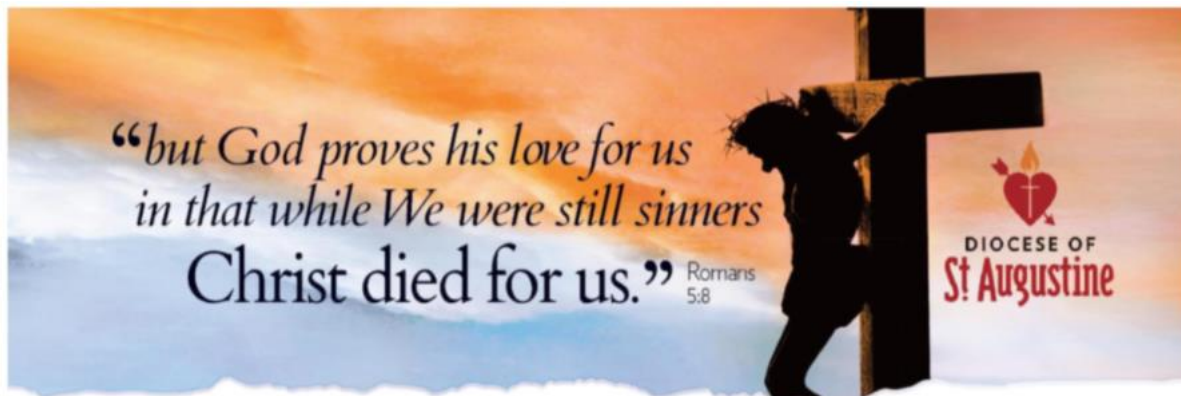
Four more death row prisoners were executed by the state of Florida in the past 2 months.

Bryan Jennings was executed by the state of Florida on Thursday, November 13, for the 1979 murder of Rebecca Kunash.

Richard Randolph (Malik Abdul-Sajjad) was executed by the state of Florida on Thursday, November 20, for the 1988 murder of Minnie Ruth McCollum.

Mark Gerald was executed by the state of Florida on Tuesday, December 9, for the 1989 murder of Tressa Lynn Pettibone.

Frank Walls was executed by the state of Florida on Thursday, December 18, for the murders of Tommie Lou Whiddon (1985), Cynthia Sue Condra (1986), Edward Alger, Ann Peterson, and Audrey Gygi (1987).



Looking ahead in 2026, more than a dozen individuals are scheduled for execution. Specific dates are not yet available due to legal proceedings and appeals. We continue to pray for those prisoners on death row and their victims. And please continue to voice your concerns to Gov DeSantis to stop these executions. Otherwise, I will continue to send you emails with the links. When you receive the email/text message, just click on the "Take Action" button to make your voice known. We've paused our bus trips out to the Florida State Prison on execution days, due to driving conditions on the rural roads in the darkness. If necessary (and we hope it won't be), we will restart the bus trips in mid-April and will continue until mid-August for future executions.
