Sign-up to attend Masses at St. Mary's:

For the last few weeks we have been having on-line sign ups for the 5:30 pm Saturday vigil, 7:30 am and 10:00 am Sunday morning Masses for both the church and parish center. MASS GUIDELINES

- Please arrive at least 10-15 minutes prior to the start of Mass.
- Enter through the side door, closest to the street, and check-in with the greeter.
- **Masks are required.** Masks are available at the door.
- Use hand sanitizer as you enter the church.
- Sit only with the people in your group and use appropriate physical distancing.
- We ask that you accompany your children to the restroom.
- During the Communion procession please keep distance between your and other groups.
