GOSPEL MEDITATION



March 13th, 2022

2nd Sunday of Lent

There is so much wisdom in the first commandment. The daily demands of life, current political ideologies and dynamics, social expectations, corporate philosophies, and even technology can easily become lesser gods. We can find ourselves beholden to and held captive by these secular constructs and systems. Even for those who profess a faith in the one true God, these lesser, attractive but false gods are a temptation. Being overly preoccupied and even obsessed with the state of our present lives, we lose sight of our real destiny and purpose.

Jesus showed his disciples a glimpse of this destiny when he was transfigured before their eyes. In fact, Peter was so caught up in the brilliance, awe, and sacredness of these fleeting moments that he wanted to extend them as long as possible. Wonderful things happen when we leave our illusions and discover something that is true. This is why creating some sacred space in our lives for reflection, prayer, renewal, refreshment, centering ourselves, and disconnecting from the noise is so important. It shows us how false and shallow our lives can be and what is really of importance. Do you create some kind of sacred space in your life? Lent is a perfect time to do so.

St. Irenaeus, one of the early fathers and martyrs of the Catholic Church, said that, “he who was the Son of God became the Son of Man that man … might become the son of God.” We mistakenly believe that life is all about us. It’s not. Ours is a journey of transformation in which we become more and more one with the mind of Christ and Christ himself. St. Augustine saw this same transformation occurring when the Eucharist is received. In receiving the Eucharist, we become what we eat, the Body of Christ. Honestly acknowledging false gods that we cling to can open the door for God to show us the wholeness and holiness to which we are called. Take time to discover the sacred. When we do, we will want to stay there for a while. Then, when we return to our personal affairs, we will see more clearly.



The façade of our Church needs a bit of love. (Really a lot of love). Over the past months we have noticed sometimes large pieces of brick become dislodged and falling from the façade. This happens when the moisture seal is compromised, and moisture enters into the façade brickwork.

Over time heating and cooling, freezing and defrosting loosen the cement between the bricks and some eventually fall out. Besides being a danger to people entering and leaving the Church, if left unattended the extent of the damage just becomes worse over time.

Therefore before things become worse we want to attend to this most needed maintenance of our beloved Church. The project involves repointing the façade on the Entrance side of the Church and Tower and also on the north side of the Church. Then we will secure any loose masonry and reseal the brick work, ensuring it will stand for more years to come.

Our Auction paddle raise this year will go directly to the Churches maintenance fund to kick start this urgent maintenance project.

Let preserve our Church for the future generations.

The Holy Sacrament of

Baptism

"Holy Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit and the door which gives access to the other sacraments. Through Baptism we are freed from sin and reborn as sons of God; we become members of Christ, are incorporated into the Church and made sharers in her mission: "Baptism is the sacrament of regeneration through water in the word." - CCC 1213

In general those wishing to have a child (under age 7) baptized here need to be registered, active members of St. Mary Catholic Church, Mt. Angel for at least six months prior to Baptism.

Parents and Godparent(s) must attend Baptismal Prep classes prior to setting Baptism date, unless excused by the pastor.

Godparent(s) must be Baptized, Confirmed, and practicing Catholics without any impediments. A letter stating such from the godparents' parish (if not from St. Mary's) will need to be submitted.

The birth certificate of the child must also be submitted

If you are not registered with the Parish of Santa Maria and live within the boundaries of another parish, we need a letter of permission from the local Pastor to administer the Sacrament of Baptism.

St. Mary's offers a online BAPTISMAL CLASS online through Agape Ministries. (Please visit website) With Baptisms taking place the third weekend of each month after the Masses, for more information & to register, contact the parish office.



The Resurrection and Spiritual Hangriness

I want to talk about being hangry. I'll give you a quick description of hangriness, though I warn you, it doesn't come from the Oxford English Dictionary. Hangriness is when you're so hungry you get angry. You turn into a real piece of work. You can't get anything done and you're probably not a joy to be around, at least until you grab a snack. Everybody gets this way sometimes.

We can be this way in our souls, too. It's so easy to get distracted by the hungers of this world: greed, pride, anxiety. We can become ruled by the needs of our bodies and the desires of our mind and, in doing so, neglect the needs and the desires of our souls.

Everyday stewardship calls us to a constant reflection on the truth that we are not made for this world, as Christ clearly shows us in his Transfiguration. He reveals himself in his heavenly glory, just before he is going to be deprived of all earthly needs and wants — even his very life. He shows us that this is what we were meant for. This is what we are striving for.

Lent exists to remind us that we are not made for this world. When you become spiritually hangry — or as Scripture more eloquently puts it this week, when your mind is “occupied with earthly things” — turn your thoughts to the Transfiguration. I promise you, it's even better than grabbing an energy bar.

Starting with early Morning Mass at 7:00 am, Evening Mass in English at 5:30 pm, Mass in Spanish at 7:00 pm and 7:00 pm Mass at Holy Rosary Crooked Finger in Scott Mills.

March 11- 6.30 pm – Stations in Spanish led by San Juan Diego group, NO Soup Supper Parish Center Setup for Auction



13 de marzo de 2022

2º Domingo de la Cuaresma

“El Señor es mi luz y mi salvación, ¿a quién he de temer? Amparo de mi vida es el Señor, ¿ante quien temblaré? (Salmo 26,1). Junto a Dios no se debe de tener temor. Hemos visto como la pandemia destrozó vidas, y aun vivimos las secuelas de esta experiencia mundial. Dejó a muchas personas sin hogar y sin trabajo, sin techo ni comida. El Sacramento del Bautismo



"El santo Bautismo es el fundamento de toda la vida cristiana, el pórtico de la vida en el espíritu ("vitae spiritualis ianua") y la puerta que abre el acceso a los otros sacramentos. Por el Bautismo somos liberados del pecado y regenerados como hijos de Dios, llegamos a ser miembros de Cristo y somos incorporados a la Iglesia y hechos partícipes de su misión" – CCC1213

Para bautizar en la Iglesia Católica de Santa María:

- * En general, aquellos que deseen tener un hijo (menor de 7 años) bautizado aquí deben estar registrados, como feligreses activos de la Iglesia Católica Santa María, Mt. Ángel durante al menos seis meses antes del bautismo.
- * Los padres y padrinos deben asistir a las clases de preparación para el bautismo antes de establecer la fecha del bautismo, a menos que el párroco lo justifique.
- * Los padrinos deben ser bautizados, confirmados y católicos practicantes sin ningún impedimento (*Por ejemplo, si están casados deberían estar por la iglesia y si son solteros deben no convivir con otra persona y deben poder comulgar*). Una carta se debe enviar a la iglesia de Santa María de parte de la parroquia de los padrinos aclarando esta verdad.
- * El certificado de nacimiento del niño tiene que ser presentado.

Si no está registrado en la Parroquia de Santa María y viven entre los límites de otra parroquia, necesitamos una carta de permiso del Párroco para administrar el Sacramento del Bautismo.


