The Young Adult Initiative is Gearing Up

After a year of listening and learning, our Young Adult Initiative (YAI) Core Team is hitting the ground running through the generous \$10,000/year grant we received from St. Meinrad.

Babysitting reimbursements—if our onsite babysitting for events doesn't fit your needs, schedule a babysitter for home and let Matt Flynn (matthewflynn5@gmail.com) know before the event that you will need a reimbursement. Reimbursements are generally good for up to 3 hours at \$10/hour. We will continue to offer onsite babysitting for many events as well. We are also conducting **listening sessions in our local community** with young adults who do not attend Church. Our initial goal is to simply hear their stories and learn how we can walk with them in their lives. Lastly, the Core Team is working on **creating opportunities** for our parishioners to better understand young adults and for young adults to feel like they belong.

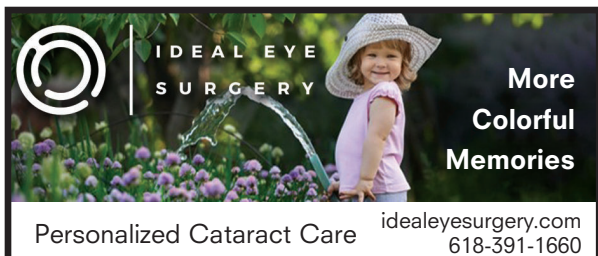

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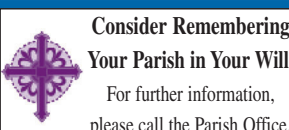


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
