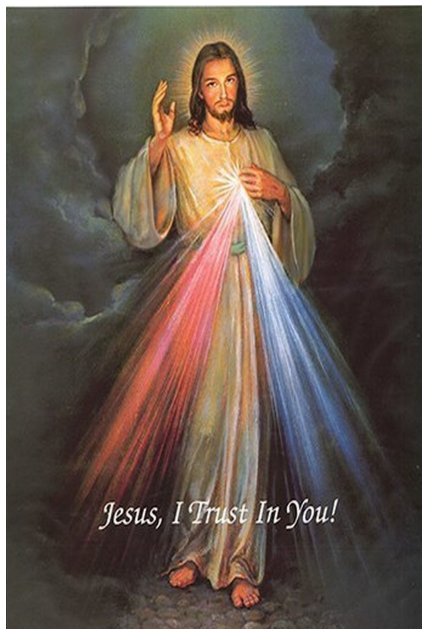

Respect Life Corner "My Lord and my God!" John 20:28

In today's Gospel, the apostle Thomas stands for each of us as he personally experiences God's mercy as he peers into the face of Jesus, the Risen Lord. Thomas failed to believe the apostles' stories that they had seen their teacher. The risen Jesus, out of abundance of love and patience, made sure that Thomas knew that he had not been abandoned.

Learn, Act, Connect and Pray—In Laudato Si (2015)

Pope Francis reminds the faithful that God never abandons us; He never forsakes His loving plan for us to live together as a whole human family. Humanity still has the ability to work together to build a common home, free of environmental degradation which is risking the lives of the world's poorest. We must have respect for the integrity of all God's people who deserve the right and access to a quality of life. We must take a look at hard issues in our world: poverty, oppression, injustice, unjust incarceration, human trafficking, as well as abortion. By allowing ourselves to be loved by Our Lord and to encounter His mercy and forgiveness in the sacraments, we are better capable of mercy, patience and forgiveness and love in the world.

Want to dive into the Sacraments?

Every year, during the Easter Season, the Church asks us to be particularly attentive to what our Christian Initiation (through the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) means for us and how we live our lives. As part of the ongoing journey of the neophytes (the newly baptized at the Easter Vigil), we hold weekly reflection sessions to discuss their experience of receiving these sacraments and their meaning for their lives. **If you would like to join us for one or more of these sessions to reflect upon your own sacramental journey and experience, please contact Matt Flynn at mattflynn@stclarechurch.org or call the parish office.** Sessions will be capped at 10 total participants.

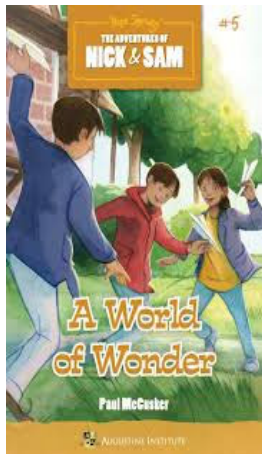

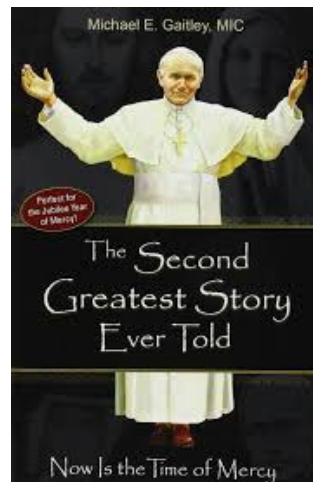


Great CD Talks and Books for Growing in Your Faith This Easter
