World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly

Saints Joachim and Anne,
Parents of Blessed Virgin Mary
and Grandparents of Jesus
Feast Day is July 26

**Pope Francis has established the
4th Sunday of July (July 25 this year)
as a day to celebrate
grandparents and the elderly.**

This is especially important this year as the elderly have been so isolated, but Pope Francis reminds us that the elderly have been an isolated part of our population for years. This celebration seeks to begin to heal and reverse that trend by encouraging us to recognize the value of each older person in our lives, to see them in the context of a family (whether or not they are grandparents), and to recognize the critical roles they play in family and social life.

The Church is granting plenary indulgences on World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly this year. A plenary indulgence is a remission of the lingering effects of our sins that have already been forgiven through the sacrament of Reconciliation by applying the merits of the Saints through our communion with them as members of the Body of Christ. The elderly can obtain an indulgence by participating in Mass on this day or if they cannot leave their homes for a serious reason by "attending" via television, radio or internet. Anyone who performs a work of mercy by visiting an elderly person who is alone can also obtain the indulgence. If meeting in-person is forbidden by health authorities, a virtual meeting will suffice.

How can you get involved?

- ♦ Visit your grandparents, neighbors or elderly friends, especially if they are alone. Take a card, flower or gift telling them how appreciated they are. Pray with them, light a candle or say a rosary for them. Offer assistance.
- ♦ **We will provide cards for kids to color for our homebound after Mass at our Coffee & Donuts on this Sunday.**
- ♦ To join a group in a visit to a local assisted living or nursing home July 25, or if you or someone you know is elderly and in need, please contact Matt at mattflynn@stclarechurch.org or 632-3562.

Has been one of the most precious gifts and highly indulgenced sacramental of our Church. It is in reality a garment given to us by Our Blessed Mother which makes us her special children.

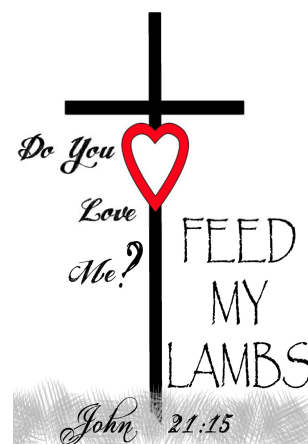
Our Lady appeared to St. Simon Stock and said "Whoever dies wearing this scapular shall not suffer eternal fire."
