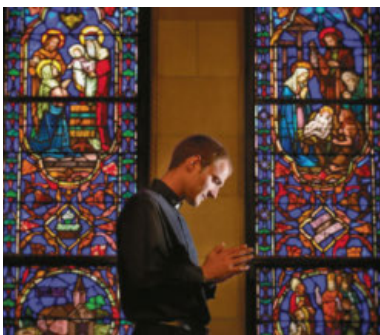

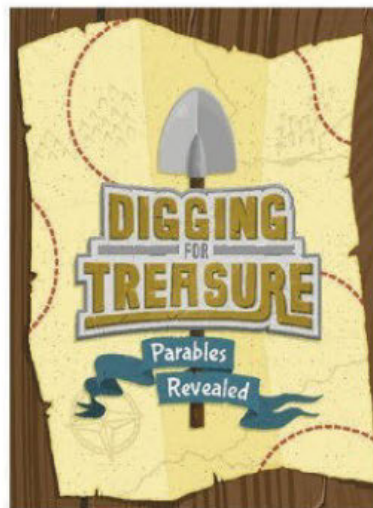


Young Adult Cooking Class at Fezziwigs:
