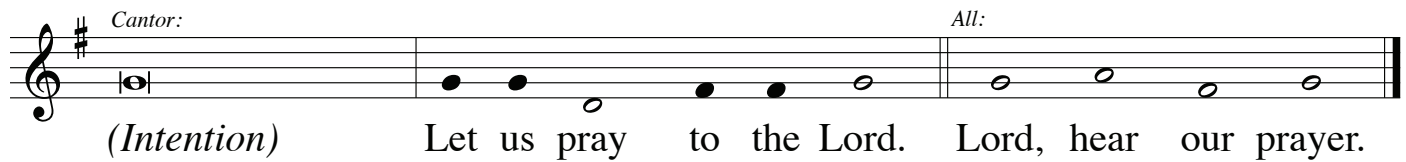


**Universal Prayer**
