

I confess to almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do,


And, striking their breast, they say: through my fault,

"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest.


Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves.



And take me home, what joy shall fill my heart. Then I shall bow, in humble adoration, And then proclaim: "My God, how great Thou art!"


Then sings my soul, My Saviour God, to Thee, How great Thou art, How great Thou art!




