We pray for the Church, keeping this solemnity in honor of the Body and Blood of Jesus: that we may renew our gratitude to our Heavenly Father, who provides for our journey with the bread that is His own Son.

We pray for our priests, ministers of Christ's new covenant which contains the promise of everlasting life: that the anointing which has sealed their souls forever may make them fervent and holy ministers of God's mysteries.

We pray for peace, and for the justice that secures peace: that we may share our bread with our hungry brothers and sisters in the same generous spirit that Jesus shares Himself as Bread with us.

We pray for all who bring the Body of Christ to the homebound and hospitalized: that they may be renewed through their service and be a support and a source of joy for those whom they serve.

We pray for a return to the sacrament of reconciliation: that God's people may approach Holy Communion free of sin and prepared for the divine intimacy of immediate contact with the living Christ.

We pray for our relationship with our sister parish, Our Lord of Esquipulas, in Guatemala: that both parishes may continue to spread the joy of the gospel and be strengthened by each other's faith, prayers, perseverance, and generosity.

We pray for our faithful departed ones, who ate the Bread of Life in faithful obedience: that the Master's repeated assurance that He will raise them to new life may become for them a living reality in heaven...and for
