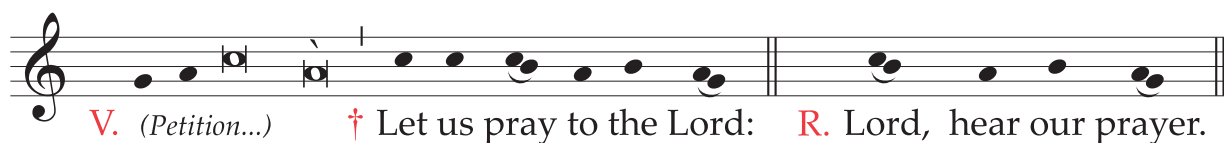


Universal Prayer
