

Our Friends in Heaven, Pray for Us: Saint Louise de Marillac was born in France in 1591. She was educated by the nuns at Poissy and wanted to become a nun but on the advice of her confessor, she married. After he died in 1625, she met St. Vincent de Paul who became her spiritual adviser. She devoted the rest of her life to working with him and directed his Ladies of Charity. This was the start of Sisters of Charity. She took her vows in 1634 and attracted many candidates. They went all over France establishing Sisters in hospitals and orphanages. By the time Louise died in 1660, there were more than 40 houses in France and now they are all over the world. Her feast day is March 15 and she is the patron saint of nurses.

A Word From Fr. Tom Niehaus



Grain of Wheat

"Amen, amen, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit (John 12:24)." When Jesus makes bold statements they usually begin with, "Amen, amen." For those of us who grow up in the rural areas planting seeds is part of the farm to food process. More than just feeding mouths, Jesus is using an analogy that will feed souls. The seed is seemingly "buried" in the ground and with moisture, heat and fertilized soil the seed will grow out of the ground. The seed which is planted seems to die, but it must be planted in the ground in order to become the fruit bearing plant it will transform into. The seed must lose its life to fulfill its purpose. Jesus offers us a double meaning to this analogy of the seed. First, a reference to his own sacrifice of his life, death, burial, and rising from the dead. Jesus must suffer and die on the cross in order to fulfill the Father's plan for the salvation of humankind. Second, each person who follows Christ must necessarily lose their former life of worldly and sinful behaviors in order to enter into eternal life. Following Christ requires each baptized person to make a choice, to choose eternal death by living a sinful life or to embrace a death to the world by leaving every worldly thing behind in order to follow Christ who will lead those who believe in him to eternal life.

St. Patrick of All Ireland

March 17th is the Feast of St. Patrick. Celebrations both private and public take place annually on this day. Parades, music concerts, toasting Irish heritage with family & friends, getting decked out in green attire and even turning the local river green is part of how many experience St. Patrick's Day. The saint himself would probably see that most of these celebrations in his honor reek of the stench of paganism and if he were alive today St. Patrick would probably be seen exercising the demons out of the revelers around the globe who do not care one bit about the missionary heroics of this holy man of God who led a nation from the darkness of superstition to the light of faith in God. Patrick was born in Britain, the son of a Roman official. Patrick was kidnapped by Irish pirates as a youth and spent six years enslaved, tending sheep in the Irish wilderness. During this time of isolation and deprivation, Patrick writes that he often prayed hundreds of times a day, asking for God's protection and guidance. Eventually, he escaped and after a difficult journey, he returned home. Then in his early 20s, he had a dream that inspired him to study for the priesthood and volunteer to return to Ireland after ordination. Recognizing the potential that Patrick's knowledge of Ireland's language and culture had, he was made the bishop of Ireland. Patrick visited parts of Ireland where no missionaries had traveled. Although he was often threatened and even imprisoned, he boldly preached to the most powerful Irish kings. Patrick traversed the island for 40 years humbly grateful to God the Father and joyfully inspired by the Holy Spirit — to preach about Jesus Christ, the Son of God. He is famous for teaching others about the Holy Trinity using the three-leafed clover or shamrock. Before his death around 460, Patrick's compassionate enthusiasm had effectively converted thousands to Christianity. The priests and religious formed in the many monasteries and convents he established spread Christianity into Northern Europe to inspire more missionaries, and Irish emigrants have spread the love of God around the world.

Lenten Encouragement

"Fasting is the soul of prayer, mercy is the lifeblood of fasting. Let no one try to separate them; they cannot be separated. If you have only one of them or not all together, you have nothing. So if you pray, fast; if you fast, show mercy; if you want your petition to be heard, hear the petition of others. If you do not close your ear to others you open God's ear to yourself (St. Peter Chrysologus)." At this point in the Lenten season, how are the disciplines of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving going for you? Have you been able to stay the course of the Lenten observances? Perhaps you have slid a little from time to time. We are in the depth of this penitential season, remain faithful to the promises and resolutions that you made in the beginning of Lent. The enemy will try to discourage you with false reasoning. Remain firm in your resolve and know that the Holy Spirit will guide you to make the steps necessary so that you can offer your heart to Jesus as you stand beside Him at the cross.




