A Word From Fr. Timothy Sandquist
Relics
In one of the Lenten small group videos about the Mass, it mentions that there are saint relics in some Catholic Church altars. A relic is a portion of a saint’s body, usually a bone fragment or a hair.
In Most Holy Redeemer’s altar, there are two relics: St. Blandina and St. Pancras. Both are early Christian martyrs of the Roman Empire. These relics were placed in the altar when the church was dedicated in 1926, shortly after the church was dedicated. We still have the paperwork for the relics, which is signed by Archbishop Dowling.
St. Patrick’s altar does not contain a relic. However, the parish does have relic of St. Patrick in the narthex display case.
Relics were required in the altars of churches built before the Second Vatican Council. However, this is no longer a requirement. The Church now prefers that if a saint relic is to be associated with an altar, it be placed beneath the altar (rather than inside) it, and that it be large enough that it is recognizable as a part of a human body (e.g., a full bone rather than a bone fragment).
