In Most Holy Redeemer's altar, there are two relics: St. Blandina and St. Pancras. Both are early Christian martyrs of the Roman Empire. These relics were placed in the altar when the church was dedicated in 1926, Dowling.

St. Patrick's altar does not contain a relic. However, the

Relics were required in the altars of churches built before the Second Vatican Council. However, this is no longer a requirement. The Church now prefers that if a saint relic is to be associated with an altar, it be placed beneath the altar (rather than inside) it, and that it be large enough that it is recognizable as a part of a human body (e.g., a full bone rather than a bone fragment).
