

A Word From Fr. Timothy Sandquist	
Pope Francis	
The Church mourns the passing of Pope Francis, who died on Easter Monday. Throughout his pontificate, he will be remembered especially for his deep compassion for the poor and the marginalized.	
His funeral Mass is being held this Saturday, April 26th, in St. Peter’s Square, six days after his death. Following the funeral, Pope Francis will be laid to rest in the Papal Basilica of Saint Mary Major in Rome, a place of special devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary.	
The funeral marks the beginning of the <i>novendiales</i> —nine days of mourning and prayer for the deceased pope—which will continue through May 4th.	
The conclave to elect the next pope begins 15 to 20 days after a pope's death or resignation (in this case, between May 6 and May 11). The word “conclave” comes from the Latin <i>cum clave</i> , meaning “with key,” referring to the locked room where the cardinals gather to vote. At the conclave, cardinals under the age of 80 are eligible to vote, and a two-thirds majority is needed to be elected. When a new pope is chosen, the cardinal dean will ask, <i>“Do you accept your canonical election as Supreme Pontiff?”</i> The papacy begins the moment the elected cardinal responds with the simple word, <i>“Accepto.”</i>	
As the world awaits the election of a new successor to Peter, let us pray for the Church and for all her shepherds.	
Divine Mercy Sunday	
Today is Divine Mercy Sunday, the second Sunday of Easter, a day when the Church celebrates the unfathomable mercy of God. Instituted by St. John Paul II in the year 2000, this feast was inspired by the visions of St. Faustina Kowalska, who recorded Christ’s desire that the Sunday after Easter be a day of mercy and trust in Him.	
The Divine Mercy image, the Divine Mercy chaplet, and the message “Jesus, I trust in You” all remind us that no sin is greater than God’s mercy, provided we approach Him with repentance.	
“On that day, the very depths of My tender mercy are open.” – Jesus to St. Faustina (Diary, 699)
