Confirmation and First Communion

Please keep our young people in your prayers who are receiving sacraments this spring. This weekend (Saturday), twenty of our 10<sup>th</sup> graders in the parish cluster were confirmed at St. Wenceslaus in New Prague by Bishop Izen. Sunday, the second graders of Most Holy Redeemer are receiving their First Communion. St. Patrick’s second graders will receive their First Communion on Sunday, May 11<sup>th</sup>.

Intinction at First Communion Masses

At the First Communion Masses, the Body and Blood of Christ will be offered by in the center Communion station by *intinction*. Intinction means the Sacred Host is dipped into the Precious Blood and both are received together. Those who wish to receive by intinction, may do so at the kneeler placed in the center aisle for this occasion – though kneeling is entirely optional. Communion by intinction can only be received on the tongue since the Host is saturated in the Precious Blood. Those who prefer to receive in the hand receive the Sacred Host in the usual way.
