Pentecost Synod Gathering

Representatives from parishes around the archdiocese gathered with the archbishop last Saturday to discuss priorities for the archdiocese. The three priorities they settled on were:

~Discipleship in Daily Life (e.g., discernment, living the Lord’s Day, financial stewardship)
~Adult Faith Formation
~Welcome and Hospitality

Archbishop Hebda will take what was discussed to prayer and issue a document in the coming months geared towards helping parishes to grow in these areas.
