

CSA Goals

Most Holy Redeemer is on track to meet its Catholic Services **Appeal** goal. With pledges accounted for, we have raised \$17,355, which is \$538 over our \$16,817 goal. We also exceeded last year's goal, which resulted in a \$985 rebate recently received by the
