A Word From Fr. Timothy Sandquist
CSA Goals Most Holy Redeemer is on track to meet its Catholic Services Appeal goal. With pledges accounted for, we have raised \$17,355, which is \$538 over our \$16,817 goal. We also exceeded last year’s goal, which resulted in a \$985 rebate recently received by the parish. St. Patrick’s still has some ground to cover. So far, \$5,645 has been raised toward our \$12,424 goal. I suspect that the CSA has less of a history of being promoted at St. Patrick’s. I encourage participation in the CSA, as it is one of Archbishop Hebda’s main initiatives to support those in need across our archdiocese. The appeal funds ministries that often cannot raise money on their own, such as hospital chaplain ministry.
MHRS Golf Fundraiser Most Holy Redeemer School will hold its 20th annual golf tournament fundraiser on Monday, August 4, 2025. The event is a four-person team scramble with a shotgun start at noon. Totus Tuus  We were blessed to welcome four energetic young adults to lead our Totus Tuus youth program this past week. The children learned about the sacraments, participated in daily Mass, and had a lot of fun along the way!
