A Word From Fr. Timothy Sandquist

The Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul

This year, the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul falls on Sunday, June 29. Because it outranks a normal Sunday in ordinary time, we are celebrating it at all Sunday (and Saturday evening) Masses. This is a special feast day for us as it is the patronal feast of our Archdiocese. Be sure to celebrate with some dessert!

Building and Grounds Projects

St. Patrick's parking lot looks great after being sealed and having the lines repainted last week! In the works is an upgrade to the electronic organ, so that it sounds less like a 1980s organ (which it is) and more like a real pipe organ. This organ has an excellent build quality. Only its electronics are outdated. We sent the board to a company that soldered in a new component that allows it to be connected to a computer with modern software. It should be ready in a few weeks!

Most Holy Redeemer has needed a joint in the roof repaired for a while now. Weather pending, a company is coming to do an in -depth investigation this week or next week. It is a very tall and steep roof, so specialized equipment is needed.

In Most Holy Redeemer School, we've been repainting the walls of the main floor and stairwells. It is starting to look really nice! This week, we are also installing a voice intercom to the electronic door entry system for safety.

Mission Appeal

Next weekend we will have a Mission Preacher from The Lamb Shall Lead International. This community, based in the Philippines, is dedicated to serving and evangelizing the poor and helping the poor to become evangelizers themselves. Funds from the appeal will be used to

- 1) replicate sustainable livelihood in urban and rural areas through livestock and organic farming in addition to formation of missionary cooperatives
- 2) establish a training center to develop capacities for management leadership and education-formation of lay missionaries
- 3) provide care for malnourished children and to help the elderly sick through medical, optical and dental healing
- 4) rehabilitate the poor affected due to outmigration, forced relocation, and natural calamities.
