

Most Holy Redeemer Roof Update

This past week, professionals conducted a detailed investigation of the church's leaky roof. They identified several issues on the parapet near the bell tower, including cracked bricks, loose mortar, and unseated flashing. Repairs to the bricks and mortar are scheduled to take place this week, with flashing repairs delayed until September due to contractor availability.

The investigation cost \$4,000, largely due to the use of an 85-foot boom lift. The upcoming brickwork will cost approximately

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd The atrium (or prepared environment) is one of the important elements that helps the relationship between God & the child to flourish. After a theme has been presented, the child is free to choose an activity that will make possible the inner dialogue with the Holy Spirit. In a traditional classroom, the primary relationship is thought to be between teacher & child. Montessori noted a third important, but often silent partner in education: the environment. Children learn more from interaction with environment than from direct instruction from a teacher. The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a method of faith formation for ages 3-12 that occurs in a prepared environment called an atrium.
