**Steubenville Youth Conference**  
Our high school youth attended the Steubenville Conference in Rochester last weekend. I was able to be there for the first half. It was a wonderful experience and seemed to have a powerful spiritual impact on those who attended. In the bulletin insert, you’ll find some pictures from the conference and our team-building activities the morning we left.

**First Reading: A Sneak Preview of the Trinity**  
This Sunday’s first reading offers an Old Testament sneak preview of the doctrine of the Trinity. God did not fully reveal Himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit until the time of Jesus. Yet, even in the book of Genesis, we see hints. The reading begins, “The LORD appeared to Abraham...as he sat in the entrance of his tent.” But in the very next verse, it says, “Looking up, Abraham saw three men standing nearby.” Abraham prepares a meal for the three, and they announce that Sarah will bear a son within the year. For readers in Old Testament times, it must have been puzzling why God would appear as three distinct persons. But with the coming of Christ and the gift of the Holy Spirit, we now understand why: our God is one in nature, but three in persons.

I have no major updates on **Fr. George** other than that he had another scan on Friday in Rochester to help determine the next steps in his treatment. Please continue to keep him in your prayers.
