The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd: The Materials

The materials in the atrium are often three-dimensional wood representations of a particular scripture or are items that represent what can be found in Baptism or Eucharist. They are attractively displayed & invite the children to explore & deepen their experience of the presentation at their own rhythm. The most important characteristic of the materials is their close link to the biblical & liturgical sources. The shelves might include maps of Israel & miniature environments representing the elements of the parables or the historical events from the infancy or paschal narratives that have been shown to satisfy the spiritual needs of the child. The model altar & its articles convey the centrality of the Eucharist. The Baptismal font & other liturgical items initiate the child into the liturgical life of the church. In The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd method of faith formation, the children work with specially prepared materials. This summer, the catechists at Most Holy Redeemer are preparing the materials for the children. 
