A Word From Fr. Timothy Sandquist

Two Causes for Sorrow

Our local and wider community has experienced two tragedies this past week. First, Fr. Victor Valencia, pastor of our parish cluster from 2014-2019, passed away last week while on a medical mission trip in the Philippines. Regarding his passing, I don’t have any more information than this. His family celebrated his funeral Mass in the Philippines on Friday, August 29th. There will be an additional memorial service in our archdiocese sometime in the coming weeks.

The second tragedy occurred at a school Mass at the Church of the Annunciation in Minneapolis on Wednesday when a shooter opened fire upon the congregation. Two children were killed, and seventeen individuals were wounded. The perpetrator, a depraved young man with an obsession with school shootings, graduated from the school in 2017.


In the face of tragedies like this, words fall short. As St. Augustine once said, “such calamities are better responded to with groans and tears than lengthy treatises.”

Some have recently scoffed at the phrase ‘thoughts and prayers,’ as if prayer were of little importance in responding to such tragedies. In reality, prayer is the most important response because policies alone cannot heal the brokenness of our fallen world. The deeper problem lies in the human heart, and this, no policy can fix. The human heart is healed by grace and grace is obtained by prayer. So, let us lift up our world in prayer, begging the Lord, as we do in the Our Father, to deliver us from evil.
