Halfway to St. Paddy’s Day Weekend

This weekend, Kilkenny celebrates Halfway to St. Paddy’s Day. We are honored to have a delegation from Kilkenny, Ireland to join us for Mass at St. Canice.

Since we are celebrating St. Patrick, I’d like to share a little bit about his life. St. Patrick was born in Britian around 386 AD. As a teenager he was kidnapped and brought to Ireland as a slave. After escaping years later, he became a priest and returned to Ireland, converting many to Christianity. His years as a slave prepared him for this missionary work by teaching him the Irish language and culture. He died in Ireland in 461.
