Fall Fundraising Letter Update

This week, Most Holy Redeemer nearly reached its goal of \$16,000 for the parish's fall fundraising appeal. As of Wednesday, about \$15,300 has been raised. \$6000 will go towards upgrading our church sound system and \$10,000 towards the church roof repair. This week, our roof contractor completed about half of the flashing in need of repair. It shouldn't be long until the church is leak free!

An appeal also went out with the invitation to the St. Canice Halfway to St. Paddy's Mass which we celebrated this past Sunday. Unfortunately, neither the higher nor the lower goal was met for the breezeway repair project. As of Wednesday, about \$700 was raised. So, we will opt to repair the breezeway with siding rather than brick.

Faith Formation Kicks Off

We've now kicked off our faith formation programs at Most Holy Redeemer and St. Patrick's. We tried a campfire and s'mores at both parishes, and it was a hit! We are grateful to all the volunteers who are helping to share the faith with our children.
