Week of the Angels

This week we celebrate two angel feast days. Monday, September 29th is the Feast of the Archangels Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. Thursday October 2nd is the Memorial of the Holy Guardian Angels. Angels are purely spiritual beings which means that they do not have bodies (though they can still appear to us in bodily form). Our knowledge of angels comes primarily from scripture. For example, Jesus says, “See that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I say to you that their angels in heaven always look upon the face of my heavenly Father.” (This is the most direct reference to guardian angels in scripture.) Just as we can ask human beings for help, we can ask the angels for help – though they are more concerned with helping us get to heaven than making our lives on earth more convenient. Here is the well-known guardian angel prayer:

Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God's love commits me here, ever this day, be at my side, to light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen.
