

**MHR Fall Festival and St. Patrick Grand Party Results**

Thanks to many helping hands, our recent festivals went amazing! They also did well for fundraising. With expenses accounted for, the MHR Fall Festival raised \$15,497, which includes a generous \$3000 donation from the Knights of Columbus. St. Patrick’s Grand Party raised \$11,511 after expenses. Most Holy Redeemer’s fall fundraising appeal which is going towards ceiling repair and a sound system upgrade did exceptionally well, raising \$29,045 which almost doubled our goal! St. Patrick’s fall appeal, which is going towards some repainting and building improvements, raised \$8520.
