


November is the month when we especially remember to pray for the dead. The Church offers a special grace known as an “indulgence” for visiting a cemetery to pray for those who have passed away. Indulgences are meant to spur us on to do acts of charity and things that help us grow spiritually. In our parish cluster we have five cemeteries directly tied to our parishes: Calvary Cemetery in Montgomery, Calvary Cemetery in Kilkenny, St. Patrick’s Cemetery in Shieldsville, St. John’s cemetery West of Montgomery; and Trebon Cemetery Northeast of Kilkenny. There are several other cemeteries in our area not affiliated with our parishes. Here is the traditional prayer for the deceased:

Eternal rest grant unto him/her/them, O Lord. And let perpetual light shine upon him/her/them. May he/she/they rest in peace. May his/her/their soul and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.
