



A Word From Fr. Timothy Sandquist

Family Formation Night Notes

I gave talks about the Mass to all of our Faith Formation families in the past couple weeks. I'd like to share a few of the main points. First, the Mass is not just a human invention, it was given to us directly by Jesus when at the Last Supper, He said, "Do this in Memory of Me." Second, the Mass, at its core, doesn't change. We celebrate the same Mass here in Minnesota as Catholics do in Japan, India, Uganda, and Mexico. Not only is the Mass the same across the world, it is the same across history. St. Justin Martyr wrote a description of the Mass in 155 AD that is strikingly similar to what we do today. And third, the Mass is almost all scripture. From the "Glory to God in the Highest" to the "Holy Holy Holy" to the "Behold the Lamb of God," the words of the Mass are almost all taken from the bible.

St. John's Cemetery Chapel

I am happy to share that the exterior work on the St. John's Cemetery Chapel is now complete. As noted last month, an anonymous donor generously funded the full replacement of the siding with a durable, high-quality material. I would like to mention permission may be sought from me to use this chapel for Catholic ceremonies such as blessings for major wedding anniversaries.
