We are continuing to keep a close eye on him.

Psalm 95

Did you know that the Psalm this Sunday, Psalm 95, is prayed by is prayed every morning by almost every Roman Catholic priest and religious in the world? This psalm has been the “wake-up call” psalm for monks for more than a thousand years. It is a psalm of praise that reminds us to listen to the Lord’s voice “today.” It also includes a warning to be on guard against hardheartedness, reminding us of the occasion when the Israelites complained against God, telling him that they would rather go back to the Egypt that he freed them from.

Here is the psalm:

¹ Come, let us sing joyfully to the Lord; cry out to the rock of our salvation. ² Let us come before him with a song of praise, joyfully sing out our psalms. ³ For the Lord is the great God, the great king over all gods, ⁴ Whose hand holds the depths of the earth; who owns the tops of the mountains. ⁵ The sea and dry land belong to God, who made them, formed them by hand. ⁶ Enter, let us bow down in worship; let us kneel before the Lord who made us. ⁷ For he is our God, we are the people he shepherds, the sheep in his hands. Oh, that today you would hear his voice: ⁸ Do not harden your hearts as at Meribah, as on the day of Massah in the desert. ⁹ There your ancestors tested me; they tried me though they had seen my works. ¹⁰ Forty years I loathed that generation; I said: “This people’s heart goes astray; they do not know my ways.” ¹¹ Therefore I swore in my anger: “They shall never enter my rest.”

March 4

As we enter the second week of Lent, the Gospel reminds us of the Transfiguration, a moment when Jesus revealed His glory to His disciples and the Father’s voice declared, “*This is my beloved Son. Listen to Him.*” This powerful message invites each of us to pause, listen, and open our hearts to God’s guidance.

In the busyness of school, activities, and daily responsibilities, listening can be difficult. Yet Lent offers us a sacred opportunity to quiet the noise and make space for God’s voice through prayer, Scripture, and moments of stillness.

This week at MHRS, our students are reflecting on what it means to listen truly: Listening to God through prayer and Scripture, Listening to teachers and classmates with respect, Listening to others by responding with kindness and compassion.

We have also been blessed by our **Mysterious Messenger and Company**, who last week spread joy by leaving positive messages on desks and in staff mailboxes, and even tulips for the staff! We are encouraging students to pass on that kindness, especially to someone they may not know well. These small acts reflect Christ’s light in our school community.
