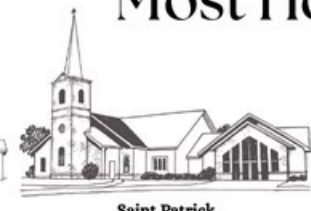

A Word From Fr. Timothy Sandquist
Divine Mercy Sunday The first Sunday after Easter is known as Divine Mercy Sunday. This is fitting because the gospel reading for this Sunday is always the passage in which Jesus gives the apostles the power to forgive sins: “Jesus breathed on them and said to them, ‘Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you withhold forgiveness from any, it is withheld’” (John 20:22). (Q: Why would a priest ever withhold forgiveness from anyone? A: If the person is unrepentant or unwilling to make a necessary change in their behavior.) This Sunday reminds us that God’s mercy is super-abundant. It is so abundant that we <i>never</i> need to fear to approach him for help and mercy when we come to him with a humble heart (even if that heart is flawed and imperfect – rather, especially if that heart is flawed and imperfect!). There are many passages from scripture that proves this – from the Parable of the Prodigal Son to the “Good Thief” crucified beside Jesus on the cross to the many times Jesus ate with public sinners. However, one passage I would like to highlight to reassure us of this is the parable of the tax collector and the pharisee. In this passage we see that approaching God with humility is the key to receiving his mercy and help. “<i>Two men went up into the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. The Pharisee, standing by himself, prayed thus: ‘God, I thank you that I am not like other men, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week; I give tithes of all that I get. ’ But the tax collector, standing far off, would not even lift up his eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, ‘God, be merciful to me, a sinner!’ I tell you, this man went down to his house justified, rather than the other. For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted.</i>” (Lk 18:10-14) Alpha Women’s Center Thank you to all how participated in the Alpha Women's Center baby bottle drive.
