A Word From Fr. Timothy Sandquist

“You Duped Me, O Lord”

Jeremiah bluntly laments to God in our first reading this Sunday, “You duped me, O LORD, and I let myself be duped” (Jer 20:7).

God called Jeremiah to be prophet. Jeremiah answered the call. But doing so caused him ridicule, rejection, and suffering.

God does not leave Jeremiah alone, though. When Jeremiah would toy with the idea of abandoning his mission, God would light a fire in his heart. He says, “*I say to myself, I will speak in his name no more. But then it becomes like fire burning in my heart. I grow weary holding it in.*”

For a Christian sincerely following the Lord, we can sometimes feel the same as Jeremiah – that we didn’t quite know what we were getting ourselves into – that things haven’t gone as we thought they would.

Nevertheless, as Jeremiah experienced, God’s grace is powerful. He strengthens us where we need it most. As St. Paul says in Philippians 4:13, “I can do all things through him who strengthens me.” So, if we ever feel *duped* by the Lord, let’s not get discouraged. Let’s instead learn to rely more on his grace and help, because when we do so, that is when he works most powerfully.
