





The Light is On For You ~ An Evening of Reconciliation will return this year and be celebrated on Wednesday, March 8, 2023. Every parish in the diocese will celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. All the priests of Southern Portage County will be present to celebrate this reconciliation at St. Peter from 7:00 to 8:00 pm.

LENTEN COMMUNAL PENANCE SERVICES

The Portage County Deanery's annual Lenten Communal Penance service this year will be celebrated on Thursday, March 30th, 7:00 PM at St. Patrick, Kent.

INDIVIDUAL RECONCILIATION is always on Saturdays 8:30 AM, at St. Joseph, or 8:30 AM at St. Peter of the Fields on Tuesday and Thursday, or by appointment with Fr. Coulter. There will be no confessions on Holy Saturday.

OPERATION RICE BOWL

The 2023 Diocesan Appeal (formerly the Bishop's Appeal) to support Catholic Charities begins Sunday, February 19. At the same time, Catholic Charities also runs the Lenten Rice Bowl, a way of collecting coins and loose change to address hunger issues among poor people. The Rice Bowl collections are taken up in little boxes especially fitted for coins. As stated in the past, it seems that this effort is focused

primarily on children as a way of sacrificing during Lent and learning of, and helping others that are needier than themselves.

St. Joseph Pastorate children will again participate in the Rice Bowl Collection. All the money collected will then be counted and added to the Bishop's Appeal since both funds go to Catholic Charities. Rice Bowl then becomes primarily a children's activity to help them participate in Lenten giving.

Therefore, as in past years, there will be two appeals going simultaneously for Catholic Charities. All the money will go to Catholic Charities through the Diocesan Appeal. Thank you for your involvement in our way of helping people throughout our area who are struggling. Rice Bowls are available at the back of the church. Children in St. Joseph School received their Rice Bowls in class.



The Holy Season of Lent

Let this season of LENT remind us all that this life we have and the material possessions we hold are just being LENT to us. We are all passersby. We are not immigrants here. We are all pilgrims on the road. We bring nothing when we die. But we can leave behind the love we have shared, the hope we have given and the goodness we have done.

A reminder during the Holy Season of Lent, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence for adults age 21 - 60, limiting yourself to one full meal and no meat. Of course, all Fridays of Lent are meatless meals.



Wednesday, February 22, is <u>ASH WEDNESDAY</u>. There will be two Masses you may chose to attend, Wednesday morning at 8:30 here at St. Joseph with the students, or Wednesday evening, 6:00 o'clock at St. Peter of the Fields. Ashes will be distributed at both Masses.
