Dear God's Family,

After His Resurrection, Jesus returned to His disciples in a glorified body, but His body still had the wounds from the cross, wounds that could be seen, felt and probed.

One of the apostles - Thomas - refused to believe when he was told that Jesus had truly risen from the dead. He doubted until he could touch the nail marks in the Lord's hands and the wound on His side.

Out of mercy for the single apostle who had missed Jesus' first appearance after rising from the dead, our Lord returned to them to invite Thomas to probe His wounds. Then Thomas, with faith we hope to emulate, immediately exclaimed, "My Lord and my God!"

On this Divine Mercy Sunday, let us ask God to strengthen our faith in order to overcome our doubts so that we, too, may see the risen Lord in our midst.

True faith inspires us to reach out to Him in the wounded and the sick, the vulnerable and the weak. We are called to be channels of hope and healing to others, so that they will experience Divine Mercy.

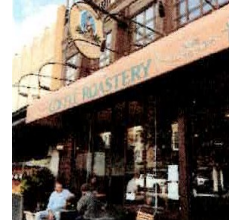

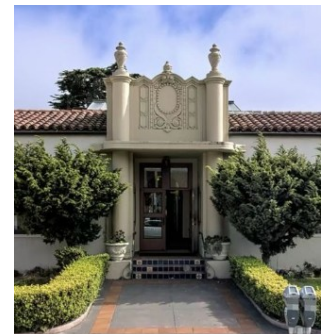
