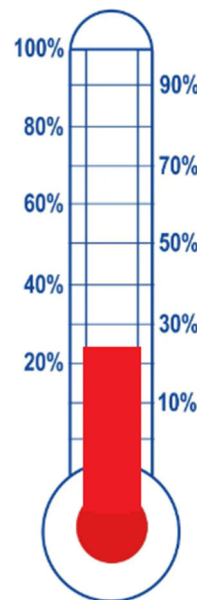

Archdiocesan Annual Appeal is like annual "tax" that every parish must "pay" to its diocese office (also known as the *chancery*), which provides expert level of business administration, such as Human Resources, Payroll, Workers' Compensation, Employee Benefits, etc.

The chancery also provides room/board for retired priests, and care for their physical, psychological, and spiritual health. It offers continuing education for active priests, and carries the work of social justice on behalf of the universal Church locally. If we do not meet our goal (our assessment for the year) we must pay the shortfall with our general fund. (Last year we paid nearly \$10,000 with it.)

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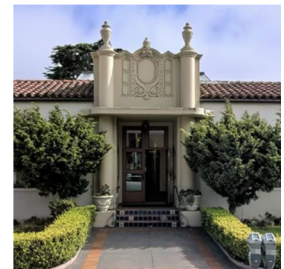
