

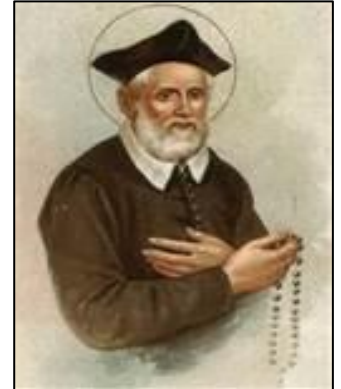
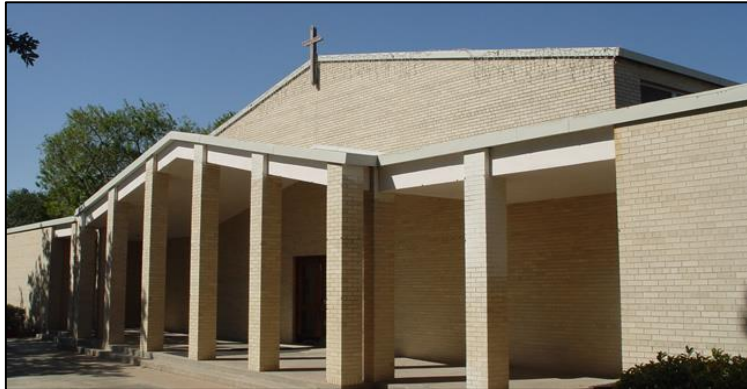

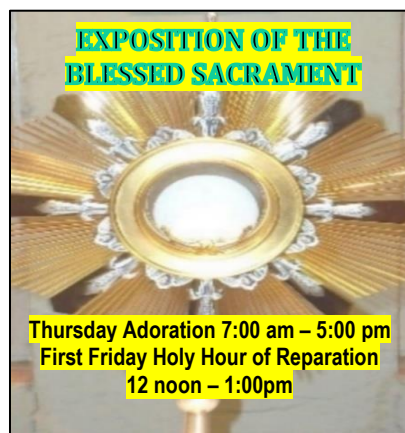

SILENT AUCTION

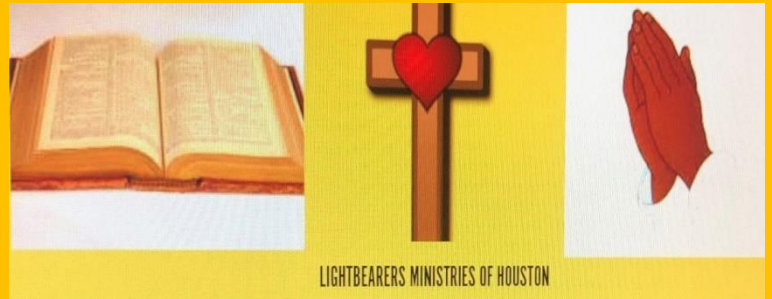

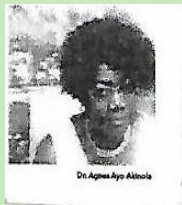
