

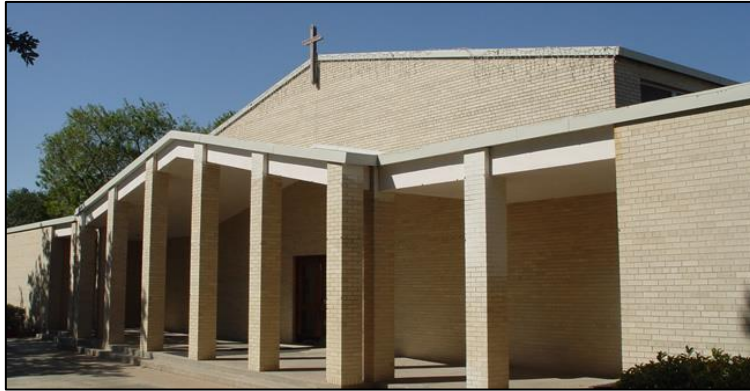

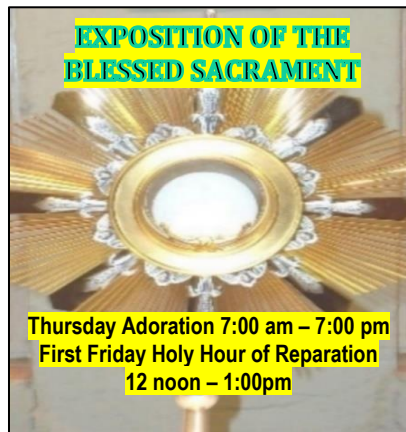

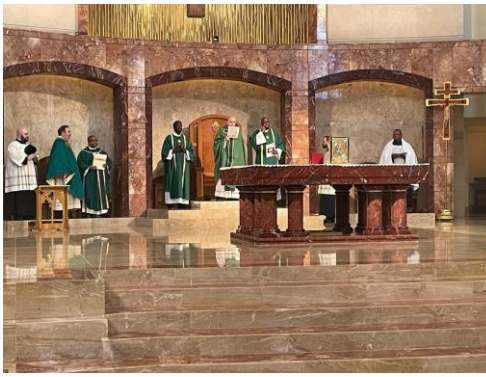
ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION

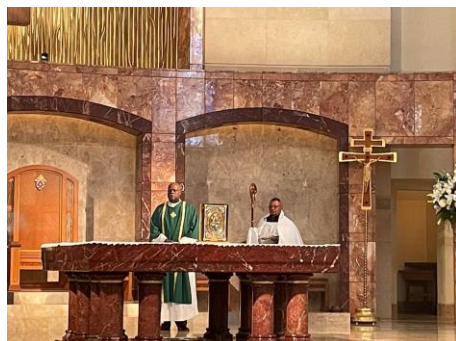

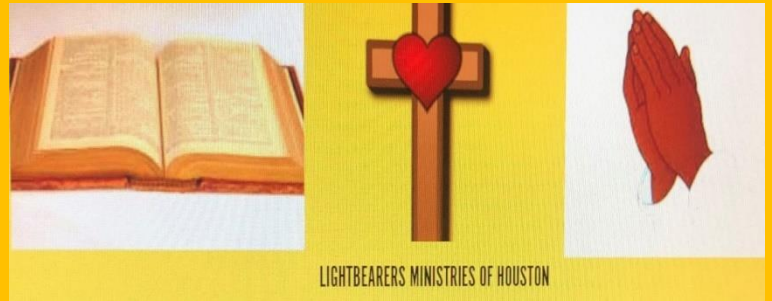

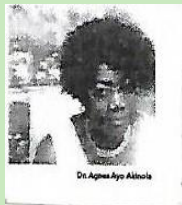
