



PASTOR'S CORNER

FULL UPDATE ON THE CHURCH AC UNITS

At an emergency meeting of our Combined Councils Executives called the previous week, we read the letter to me by the Bishop Chancellor of the Archdiocese. The Archdiocese resolved to foot the cost of providing the 30 tons of AC for the sanctuary at \$129,675.00 and cancelled the building of a new rectory, because the cost is prohibitive at the former approved grant at this time.

Regarding the estimated cost of the offices. Chapel and classrooms ACs of \$14,900.00 each prepared by NDH Service, the Executives at meeting zoom with Archdiocesan officials isolated 5 units for immediate usage totaling \$74,500.00. We requested a grant for 50% of this amount and a loan for the other 50% from the Archdiocese. With the grant and the loan, if approved, we will switch over to the new systems as proposed by NDH Service. Our present AC units are old and are phasing out.

Going forward, we are to continue with aggressive fundraising activities for the funding of the other 7 units of classrooms, and for the 50% loan. For these reasons, let us fully participate in a wonderful bazaar spirit September with fish fry, Raffle books sale, Super Bingo, etc. and raise money for our parish facilities. Let us prove to ourselves and to the Archdiocese that we can run our parish gracefully.




