

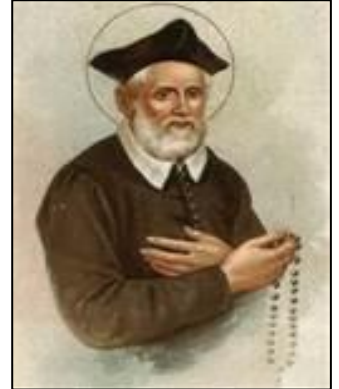

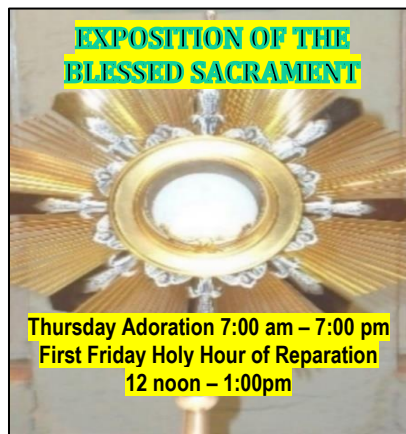

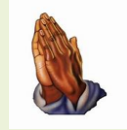

GENERAL ELECTION

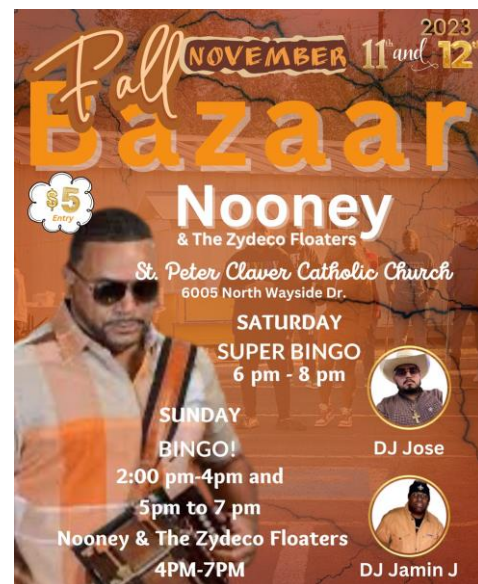
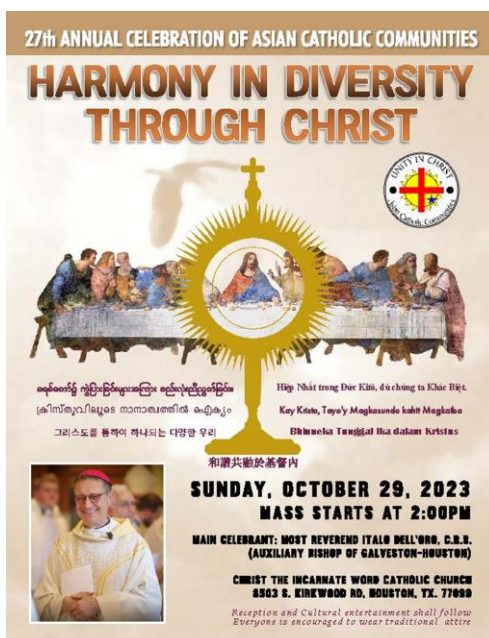
St. Philip Neri will be hosting the General Election on November 7th, 2023. Doors will be open at 5:30 a.m.

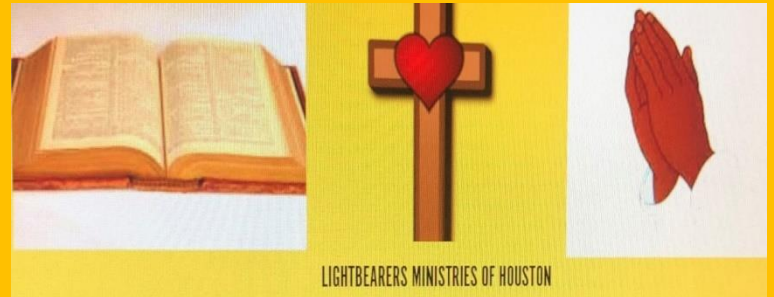

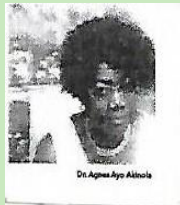
