FROM FATHER SEIBT

Greetings in the Lord!

Saint Paul, in our second reading today from his Letter to the Philippians, summarizes the trajectory of the Christian life:

"Forgetting what lies behind, but straining forward to what lies ahead, I continue my pursuit toward the goal, the prize of God's upward calling, in Christ Jesus" (Phil 3:8-14). This is what is at the heart of today's Gospel according to John (In 8:1-11). Jesus tells the woman caught in adultery: "Neither do I condemn you. Go, and from now on do not sin any more." This is the "something new" the prophet Isaiah tells us in our first reading that the Lord is doing (Is 43:16-21). God is renewing us with his love and mercy! While Lent is a time for us to turn away from sin, it is also a time for us to be reminded of the fact that God loves us and forgives us. This should be our motivation to "go and sin no more." In other words, to keep moving forward pursing our identity and calling in Christ and the glory that awaits us because of his saving work, which we are about to celebrate in a special way in the days ahead.

On this **fifth Sunday of Lent**, you will notice that our crosses and statues are veiled. Veiling them indicates that we are in a different/unique time, shifts our attention to the words being proclaimed or prayed at Mass, and produces a heighted sense of anticipation of Good Friday and Easter. The crosses will remain covered until the end of the celebration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday and the statues will remain covered until the beginning of the Easter Vigil.

Tonight, we are blessed to have at least eight priests coming for our **Penance Service**. Please take advantage of this wonderful opportunity to go to confession.

Please continue to check out our **Holy Week schedule** and join us in celebrating the suffering, death, and resurrection of the Lord anew!

Many thanks to all who are supporting our fish fry! Don't forget to **VOTE** us number one!

Let us continue to pray for peace in **Ukraine**. May Mary, Queen of Peace, obtain the grace needed to change minds and hearts.
