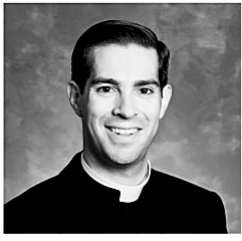

FROM FATHER SEIBT

Greetings in the Lord!

A special **welcome** to those who may be visiting us today.

"The Lord is risen. He is risen, indeed. Alleluia! Alleluia!" This is what we as Christians proclaim and live: Christ has conquered sin and death and has opened for

us the gates of heaven. This is what brings us joy today and every day: that this is not all there is; that God has prepared a place for us in his Kingdom and that, as we make our way back to him, he is with us always.
