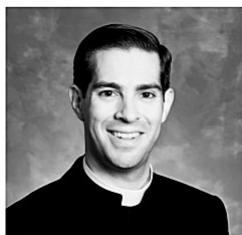

FROM FATHER SEIBT

Greetings in the Lord!

A special **welcome** to those who may be visiting us today.

"Christ is risen! Alleluia! Christ is truly risen! Alleluia! Alleluia!" As we

continue to reflect on the Christian life as a long night's journey into day, another aspect of the light of eternal life toward which we are tending is placed before us today in the Gospel according to John: the light of the shepherd. Jesus proclaims, "the shepherd walks ahead of [his sheep], and the sheep follow him." How refreshing that we do not have to try and find our own way! And how refreshing that when we try to do so and go astray, Jesus leads us back to himself, the "gate" through which we enter to "be saved" (Jn 10:1-10). He is "both Lord and Christ" (Acts 2:14a, 36-41). He "bore our sins in his body upon the cross, so that, free from sin, we might live for righteousness" (1 Pt 2:20b-25). So, let us follow him for when we do there is "nothing we shall want" (Ps 23: 1-3a, 3b4, 5, 6).

Today we observe **World Day of Prayer for Vocations**. The purpose of this day is to publicly fulfill the Lord's instruction to, "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest" (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2). Please pray that young men and women hear and respond generously to the Lord's call to the priesthood, diaconate, religious life, societies of apostolic life or secular institutes. Join

Bishop Lucia in praying a special holy hour for vocations this Wednesday, May 3rd at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception beginning at 5:30 PM.

We welcome Bishop Cunningham who will confer the **Sacrament of Confirmation** on the youth of our parish who have been preparing to receive it for the last two years. They have attended Mass every Sunday and on Holy Days, learned more about the faith, and put the faith in action through service. Please pray that by the power of the Holy Spirit this good work that has begun in them will continue.

This Friday **B.A.R.** (Building Authentic Relationships) will meet. It is for all married couples – young and old. I highly recommend it. Pray that more married couples will attend so that we can build stronger families of faith.

This Saturday is **opening day** for Central Square Little League. We are happy to welcome so many families from our community here to our campus. I am honored (and nervous!) to be throwing the first pitch. Please pray that hearing the new bells, seeing the church, and meeting parishioners, they may be led to contemplate the things of heaven.
