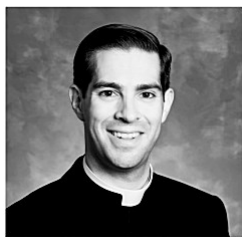

FROM FATHER SEIBT

Greetings in the Lord!

A special **welcome** to those who may be visiting us today.

This weekend we celebrate another one of the great mysteries of our faith: the **Solemnity of the Most**

Holy Body and Blood of Christ. What is the Eucharist? It is the ritual action by which we remember the saving work of the Lord in such a way that it becomes present to us (Dt 8:2-3, 14b-16a). It is ritual action through which we participate in the body of Christ broken for us and the blood of Christ poured out for us (1 Cor 10:16-17). It is the ritual act in which we eat and drink the flesh and blood of the Son of God and so have life within us (Jn 6:51-58). Do we believe this like the disciples who followed Christ because they recognized that he alone has "the words of eternal life?" Or have we gone back to our former ways of life like those who followed him but then found this saying hard to accept?

Today (Sunday), there will be a special **Eucharistic Procession** after the 10:30 AM Mass. All are invited to participate. A special invitation to the families of our parish for their children to be part of the Mass and procession.

We are in the second year of our national **Eucharistic Revival**. Let us pray that our efforts as a Church will strengthen our faith in the Eucharist and draw those who have left back into the fold.

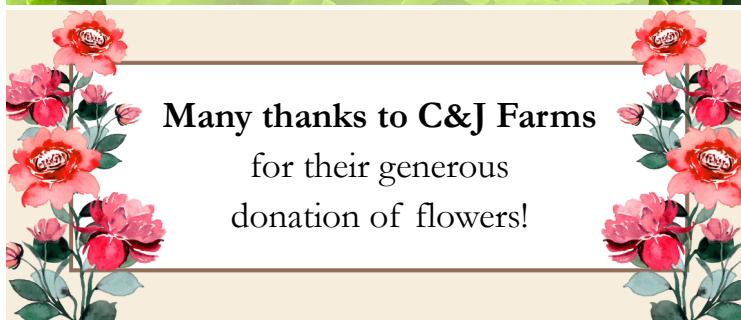
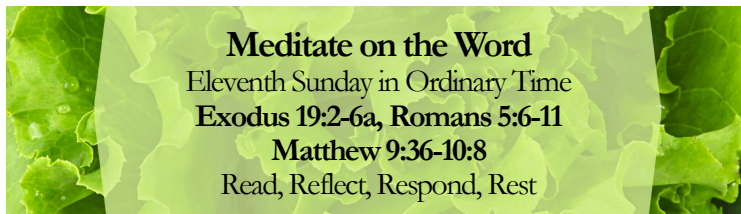

THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY

“*Corpus Christi* (the Body and Blood of Christ) is a Eucharistic solemnity, or better, the solemn commemoration of the institution of that sacrament. It is, moreover, the Church's official act of homage and gratitude to Christ, who by instituting the Holy Eucharist gave to the Church her greatest treasure. Holy Thursday, assuredly, marks the anniversary of the institution, but the commemoration of the Lord's passion that very night suppresses the rejoicing proper to the occasion. Today's observance, therefore, accents the joyous aspect of Holy Thursday” (*The Church's Year of Grace*, Pius Parsch).



“This Feast invites us to contemplate the supreme Master of our faith: the Blessed Eucharist, the real presence of the Lord Jesus Christ in the Sacrament of the altar.... Every time that the priest renews the Eucharistic Sacrifice, in the prayer of consecration he repeats: ‘This is my Body... this is my Blood.’ He says this lending his voice, hands and heart to Christ, who wanted to stay with us and be the heartbeat of the Church.

Indeed, an intrinsic connection exists between celebration and adoration. In fact, Holy Mass is in itself the Church's greatest act of adoration: ‘No one eats of this flesh,’ as St Augustine writes, ‘without having first adored it’ (*Enarr. in Ps. 98,9: CCL XXXIX, 1385*).



Adoration outside Holy Mass prolongs and intensifies what has taken place in the liturgical celebration and makes a true and profound reception of Christ possible.

Today, then, the Eucharistic procession is taking place in Christian communities in all parts of the world. It is a special form of public adoration of the Eucharist, enriched by beautiful and traditional expressions of popular devotion.

In life today, often noisy and dispersive, it is more important than ever to recover the capacity for inner silence and recollection. Eucharistic adoration permits this not only centred on the ‘I’ but more so in the company of that ‘You’ full of love who is Jesus Christ, ‘the God who is near to us’” (*Benedict XVI, Address of June 10, 2007*); (source: <https://www.catholicculture.org/>).
