

Reintroduction of the Distribution of the Precious Blood of Christ

During this month dedicated to the Precious Blood of Christ, communion under both species will begin to be available again now that all COVID-19 protocols are no longer in effect. The reintroduction will take place the weekend of July 29th/ 30th. Reception of the Precious Blood of Christ is not mandatory, but optional. Nevertheless, "Holy Communion has a fuller form as a sign when it takes place under both kinds. For in this form the sign of the Eucharistic banquet is more clearly evident and clearer expression is given to the divine will by which the new and eternal Covenant is ratified in the Blood of the Lord, as also the connection between the Eucharistic banquet and the eschatological banquet in the Kingdom of the Father" (General Instruction of the Roman Missal, 281).
