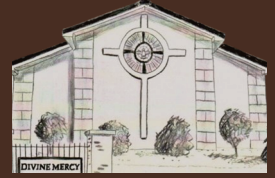

FROM FATHER SEIBT

Greetings in the Lord!

Fear paralyzed the servant in today's Gospel who buried his Master's talent in the ground (Mt 25:14-30). Consequently, he was not ready when his master came back to settle his account with him.

Sometimes fear of the end of our lives and/or of the Lord coming again in glory can paralyze us and cause us to stop living the Christian life. If we give in to this fear, we too will be caught off guard when the Lord comes. So, let us heed the words of Saint Paul in our second reading: "You yourselves know very well that the day of the Lord will come...Therefore, let us not sleep as the rest do, but let us stay alert and sober" (1 Thes 5:1-6).

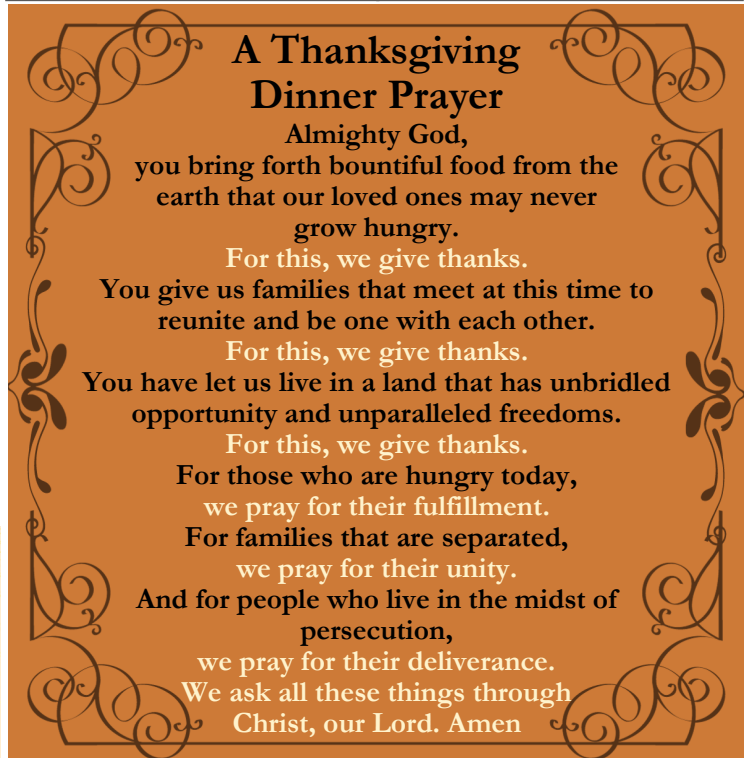
