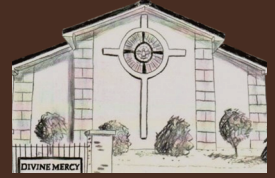

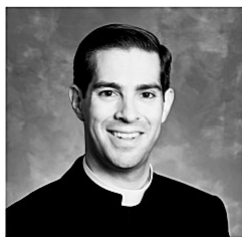

### FROM FATHER SEIBT
